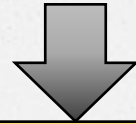



# Points To Note For 'ADD VIDEO' Section

## Video Link

- While adding link in the 'video link' section, only the embed codes\* of the videos are to be inserted. Direct link of the video will not load on the site.

## Video Title


- The 'Enter Video Title' section, allows 36 characters with spaces (approximately) and 45 characters without space (approximately).

## Rating

- The section of 'Rating' allows you to rate the video up to '5' only.

## Video Description

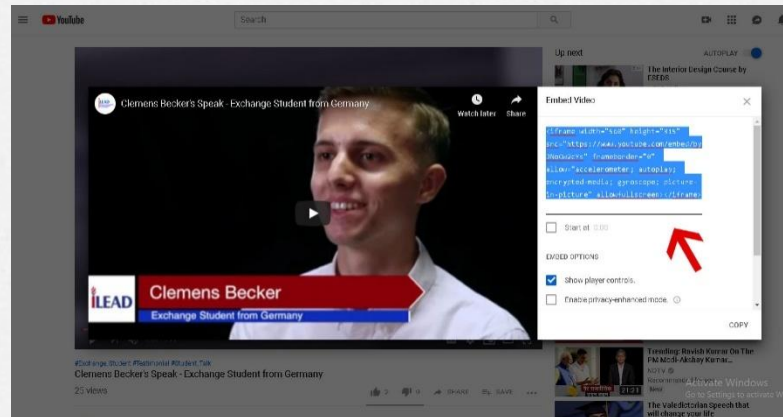
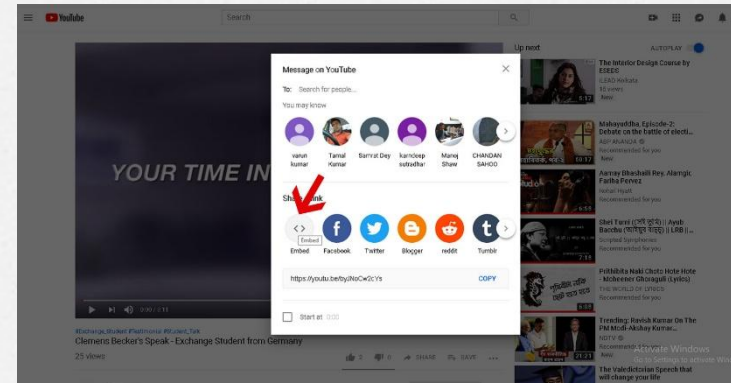
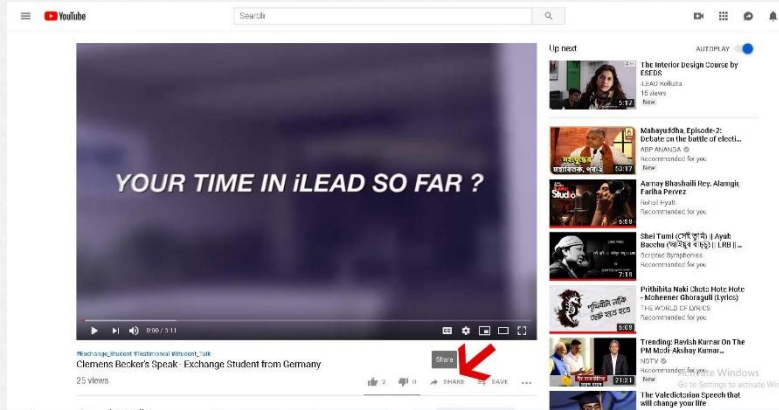
- The section of 'Video Description' allows approximately 90 characters.


